Principal's Message



***Don't Flinch or Fear.
Let's Turn Challenges
into Opportunities Together!***

1. Achievements in Public Examinations & Extra-curricular Activities

The last academic year (2010-11) was a fruitful year for Wong Siu Ching because our students attained remarkable achievements in both academic and non-academic areas. In the Advanced Level Examination, 62 students sat for the examination and they obtained a total of 24A's, 29B's and 57C's, which is the best result ever in our school. The overall passing and credit rates were 93.6% and 38.2% respectively. One of our best performing students got 3 Distinctions and 2 Credits whereas two of them obtained 3 Distinctions and 1 Credit. While 91% of our students received admission offers, 71% were admitted to university degree programmes.

Our students performed equally well in extra-curricular activities. For instance, we were awarded the Overall Sports Championship of the Year for the first time owing to the outstanding performance of our sports team. Besides sports, we won numerous prizes and awards in interschool debating, music, drama and speech competitions in the past academic year.

To widen the exposure and instill positive values among our students, our teachers spare no effort to organize learning programmes and extra-curricular activities during the summer vacation. For example, we provided opportunities for students to take part in educational tours to the UK, Singapore, Taiwan and the Mainland. We had training camps for students to develop their leadership skills. There were also Summer English Courses, a Form 1 Orientation Camp and a Wall Painting of the school motto to enhance students' language proficiency and cultivate their sense of belonging to the school.

2. Major School Concern of the Year

To help everyone understand the direction of school development which is of paramount importance to our students' effective learning, I would like to mention the three major school concerns of this year.

First Concern: To promote assessment for learning

Assessment for learning is a process in which teachers will try to use different kinds of assessment to find out students' learning problems and show them suitable ways to improve their work. Students will find teachers using various means such as newspaper commentaries, projects, on-line tests, oral presentations, etc. to help them learn better. Sometimes, they may be asked to evaluate their own performance or classmates' performances. It is hoped that these assessments will help students understand their own performance and know how to improve.

Second Concern: To fully develop students' potentials

Students will be encouraged to join extra-curricular activities and competitions outside school. For Junior Form students, we will introduce the 'One Person One Competition' Scheme which aims at encouraging them to open themselves up to outside activities. We will notify students of all activities outside school by posting them on the web and on the notice boards. To show our recognition and appreciation of students' achievements, we will display outstanding work or awards at various locations in school or publish them in the "Ringing Ten".

For Forms 4 & 5 students, we will set up a ‘15-hour service commitment’ benchmark. We expect every student to have at least one service experience a year outside school. We hope that through community services, students’ potential and talents can be fully exploited and a spirit of serving the community as well as a positive attitude towards life can be developed.

Third Concern: To help students build up their character and reinforce their positive values

In addition to academic and intellectual development, our school puts strong emphasis on fostering positive values. We believe that life is incomplete if we care for ourselves without caring for others. That is why we adopt ‘Care and Concern’ as our core value this year. We hope our students will not only excel in academic work but also know how to discipline themselves and contribute their knowledge and ability to people around them. Apart from showing empathy and love, we should take action to help those who find themselves powerless due to misfortune. That is why we want students to join extra-curricular activities and community service, so that they can learn to respect, understand and cooperate with other people, through playing and working with them.

3. A Word of Advice and Encouragement

To the Form 6 & Form 7 students facing the Advanced-level and the Diploma of Secondary Education (DSE) exams, I know many of them may feel extremely stressed. They may worry that there is not enough time to finish the syllabus. They may be puzzled with the School-based Assessment or find the new subject, Liberal Studies, very demanding. They may be troubled with the high expectations of themselves, their teachers or parents.

In the face of all this, they will not be alone as we will offer them proper guidance and support. The teachers will fully prepare them for the examination by giving extra support like extra-lessons and supplementary materials, as well as individual counselling. I have also established channels of communication like the principal’s letterbox and meetings with student representatives for them to express their needs and concern.

As Franklin Roosevelt the 32nd American President said, “There is nothing to fear but fear itself!” With strong will, confidence and perseverance, students can ultimately overcome any difficulties. The new academic year is full of challenges which will become good opportunities if students learn how to face them properly. I strongly believe that under the careful guidance of our teachers as well as students’ own strenuous efforts, we will make it another enjoyable and rewarding year together.

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校舍開放時間：

(一) 學校大閘之開啓時間為：

星期一至五：上午七時十五分至下午七時

星期六：上午九時至中午十二時，同學須於十二時前離校。

(二) 除學校所組織之球類活動外，所有球類活動必須於下午六時前停止。

(三) 所有同學必須於下午七時前離校。參與學校組織之課外活動之同學亦必須於下午七時前離校。

(四) 自修室：本學年為雙學制年，由於班級及人數增加，學校設施之使用非常緊張，目前可供同學於午膳及放學後自修之地點有：新翼地下之多用途場，圖書館自修室及六樓自修廊。

開放時間：上述各自修地點於星期一至五每天開放至下午六時四十五分，自修同學須自律及保持安靜，以免影響他人，違規同學按校規處分。

(五) 由於中六及中七兩級同學須要準備應付公開考試，在有需要情況下，學校將會考慮增加自修室，以便同學留校溫習。

(六) 圖書館開放時間為：星期一至五上午八時三十分至下午五時。



借用課室：

- (一) 各課室於午膳及下課後關閉，由工友鎖門及清潔，同學不得借故逗留及影響工友工作。
- (二) 同學如需借用課室進行活動，負責同學必須徵得活動老師之同意，並遵守借用課室規則(不可使用電腦及投影機)，於校務處領取及填寫借用課室表格，表格最遲於借用當天下午小息前交回校務處辦理，逾時恕不受理。
- (三) 一般情況下，同學不可借用特別室(包括實驗室/禮堂/MMLC/CAL/語言實驗室等)。以上設施必須由負責老師提出並在場指導下才可借用。
- (四) 位於地下之會議室, 001 至 006 室為老師會見學生、家長、訪客及進行會議等用途，同學不可擅自使用。

小食部轉換承辦商：

由於校方與小食部承辦商提早解約，學校經諮詢家長教師會及學生會代表之意見後，本學年由「冠萬國際」承辦本校之小食部，並由「小食部委員會」監管，定期與承辦商檢討有關服務；委員會成員有陳紹基副校長，嚴麗意老師，家長教師會和學生會代表，歡迎家長和同學向他們提供有關小食部服務之意見。

惡劣天氣停課安排



根據教育局通告，本校將按天氣影響上課的措施，作下列安排：

一．熱帶風暴

1. 若天文台仍未懸掛八號或上的風球，教育局沒有特別廣播宣告停課，本校將照常上課。
2. 當天文台懸掛八號或以上的風球，學校便即停課，並根據教育局的指示安排學生離校。
3. 如在學生上課途中懸掛八號風球，學校將實施「應變計劃」；開放校舍，安排教職員回校照顧返抵學校的學生，並在安全的情況下安排學生返家。

二．雷暴豪雨

1. 若早上遇有持續大雨，學生應注意電台或電視台是否有教育局的特別報告，始離家返校。
2. 除非教育局透過廣播作特別公佈，否則在黃雨警告信號下，學校仍照常上課。
3. 若天文台於早上六時十五分或之前發出紅色或黑色暴雨信號，教育局將宣佈停課。
4. 若教育局於早上六時十五分後才公佈停課，學校將實施上述「應變計劃」。
5. 若天文台在上課時間內發出紅色或黑色暴雨信號，學校將繼續上課，直至正常下課時間而學生可安全返家為止。

三．上課日、測驗考試及特別活動之安排

1. 若教育局宣佈停課，當天之學校上課日當告取消，翌日依照校曆表的原定日次上課。
2. 學校測驗/考試期間受停課影響之科目，將會另行安排日期舉行測驗/考試。
3. 特別活動日（如陸運會/外展日等）若遇天氣欠佳，但教育局並無宣告停課，學生仍應前往舉行活動之場地或集合地點報到。本校將衡量天氣狀況，再決定活動是否如期舉行。

由於本港各區惡劣天氣環境不一，故即使教育局並未宣佈停課，家長/監護人若認為天氣或道路交通情況欠佳，仍可自行決定不讓子女上課，但請當日早上致電回校請假，並請於翌日補辦請假手續。如有任何有關天氣影響上課之問題，家長/監護人可致電 (24140157) 向校務處關小姐查詢。
