Real-time Learning

To develop students a more systemic learning routine, starting from April 20, F1 to F3 students are required to attend real-time lessons every afternoon, from 1.20 pm to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday. Kindly note that additional information for each subject will be issued through the E-class later.

Student Support

In addition to the teaching arrangements, the following measures will be introduced to support our students:

- Students who require special learning and emotional support will be contacted by their class teachers, school counsellor and social worker to ensure their needs are understood and well addressed.
- 2. For students who require financial aid, the school will supply them with I-pads to facilitate online learning. Please contact our office staff if you are in need of the service. We have also participated in a number of programmes organised by various NGOs to provide free sim cards and laptops to students on a need basis.
