

Information on Application for Secondary 1 (S1) Discretionary Places (2021)

Welcome to our admission page and thank you for your interest in applying to our school.

F.1 students are admitted through Feeder System, Central Allocation and by application according to the EDB Secondary School Place Allocation (SSPA) System. Starting from 2021, applicant for Secondary 1 (S1) Discretionary Places must attend an interview for admission.

A. Admission Procedures for S1 Discretionary Places

1. Distribution of Application Forms:

Applicants may obtain Application Forms and relevant information by:

- a) coming in person to the school during office hours
from **30 November, 2020** to **18 January, 2021**; or
 - b) downloading the Application Form from the school website ([form](#)).
- (Please use **white** A4 paper)

2. To complete the application process, please return the following **IN PERSON** to the School General Office during the time 9:00 am - 12:30 pm / 1:30 pm - 4:30 pm (Mon-Fri) and 9:00 am - 12:00 nn (Sat) from **4 to 18 January, 2021**, both dates inclusive.

- a) the application form for S1 Discretionary Place issued by the Education Bureau;
- b) the completed School Application Form;
- c) two stamped (\$2.0) self-addressed envelopes (4" x 9");
- d) **photocopies** of the following documents:
 - P.5 to P.6 school report cards (P.5 – all school terms; P.6 – only 1st term).
 - certificate of awards stated in the application form.

If you are not issued with the P.6 1st Term report card in mid-January, you can submit the copy of the report card in person on or before **19th February, 2021 (by 4:00 pm)**.

There is **NO NEED** to provide recommendation letters of the primary schools and certificates of awards, extra-curricular activities or services which have been shown in the school report cards.
