The most effective English activities in students' eyes

中二學生選出最有效益的英語活動 (from F2C's Writing Assignment)

© English Morning Assembly

In the assembly, some students go on stage to present something interesting. We can learn things from their presentations. Students speak English on the stage. If we want to understand them, we have to pay attention. This can improve our listening skill.(Lam King Long)

I also like the EMA. Students have to speak in English on the stage. Students who are nervous on stage will

become more courageous after their performance. They can build up their confidence as they have to speak in front of about four hundred people in the hall. The experience can surely improve their spoken English. (Yung Siu Lam)

I think the EMA is the most effective English activity. I did a show in the EMA last year. We had to practise and practise before we performed on stage. The teacher who trained me taught me how to pronounce clearly, how to use good words and so on. During the rehearsals, I learnt a lot. When I presented what I had prepared on stage, I felt happy. The experience has made me braver to speak in English with the others. (Yuen Kin Yu)

EMA is a time for students to perform on stage. It provides us a chance to practise our English speaking and acting skills. When we stand on stage, we will get support from our friends. It gives us a sense of achievement. The students who lack courage can build their confidence there. Another reason that I love the EMA is that it can test our creativity. © Extensive Reading Scheme (ERS)

ERS is a scheme that allows us to read story books in the lesson. I like it the most. Actually, I did not like reading books at first. I thought it was a waste of my time. However, I found some interesting books in the ERS boxes and I started to love reading. I can build my vocabulary bank by reading the ERS books. (Lam King Long)

In all the English activities, I like the ERS most. There are many reading levels. We have to read about twenty to twenty five books before we move up to the next level. I think it is exciting. In the ERS lessons, students have to present a book to the class with the help of the PowerPoint. Some presentations are absolutely amazing. (Yuen Cheuk Kan)

Some ERS story books are very interesting. I enjoy reading them. I know that my English vocabulary pool is not big enough. Through reading ERS books, I can learn a lot of useful words. Also during the process of answering the questions on the question cards, I can improve my comprehension skill and get higher marks in the exams. (Chu Hung Choi)

ERS is a scheme that pushes me to read a book each week. The books are classified into different levels, from levels G to X. I am reading Level D books. Most of them are very exciting. I love them. I hope I can learn more vocabulary from the books and use them in the compositions. (Au Yeung Chun Wah)

I like the ERS because it can improve our writing skill if we read more. There are many interesting ERS books. We don't have to pay for them. We can read them for free. After we read about twenty-five books, we take a test. When we get the test result, we know what our reading level is. It is exciting. Also, we have book sharing sessions in the ERS lessons. We can share some interesting books with our friends. It is fun. (Yip On Ni)

I think the ERS benefits me most. I am eager to read ERS books because I want to go up a higher level. Through reading, I can learn a lot of vocabulary. I usually keep them in my notebook and use them in my free writing. I can also learn the writing skills from the writers. Some ERS books can enhance my knowledge as they give me information about science and historical figures.(Cheung Ling Sin)
