## Overcoming Difficulties in Learning English

### Situation

Every year, when the HKEAA DSE Reports are published, without having to look at it, you can guess our students would usually do better in reading and writing as they have to recite large piles of textbooks and readers outside the classroom for their assignments & tests. Thus quantity change leads to quality change.

### Problem

Oral is their 2<sup>nd</sup> weakest subject as they don't have a regular partner to chat with every day. And the weakest in the HKDSE is listening. They just don't have a habit to tune into an English channel on their radio or TV at a regular time, listen, jot notes, & organize their notes to tell someone else, whether in spoken or written form.

### Solutions

Is there a remedy? Yes, as successfully proven out by Wong Tan Tan, the girl who went to England on the Rotary Scholarship in F.2. She also beat hundreds of other students from famous schools and got the Best Delegate Award with three of our F.6 students in the Hong Kong International Model United Nations in F.4

### 4 Skills every day

How did she do that? This is what she says, *"When I was in Form 2, I chatted with a classmate every day in English, making it a habit. Actually, I did writing, reading, speaking and listening every single day. And I marked them as record. It is what my English teacher asked us to do and it is the KEY to learning English."*

### Oral

Kyoko Wong, another Rotary Scholar, also gave us her tip: *"Be brave! This is the most important thing. You won't master a language by just reading and listening to it. You gotta speak it **LOUDLY** and use it whenever you get the chance. Many students are not confident enough to speak because they know they are not experts. But it doesn't really matter, as long as you keep speaking and trying, you will master it one day."*

### Listening

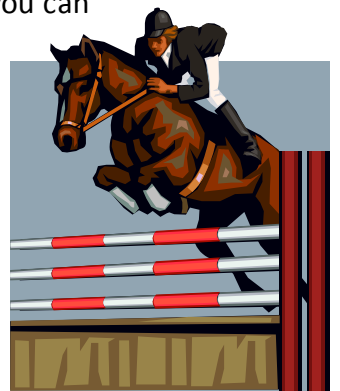
For listening, Marco Li has just downloaded an app on his mobile phone to listen to the Documentaries on BBC Radio. *"It is much better than watching Ted.com cos I always read the subtitles & don't listen to what is said. It is not difficult at all as each 30 min programme is on one topic. The vocabulary keeps repeating itself. It's much slower than news and it's about the same length as a DSE listening comprehension."*

### What the school is doing to help

The English Department is doing everything they can to help. In the morning, we have the BBC listening in the M.I. room. During lunch time, we have foreign movies for lower forms students to enjoy. At the beginning of every year, we have the HK Speech Festival to polish your speaking skills and the mentoring program to let you speak with a partner. If you like writing, you can pour your heart out in your free writing. If you love reading, we have the Extensive Reading Scheme and Online exercises. Make good use of them.

- 同學可考慮開始溫習時先處理最難或最需要記憶的，到溫習末段，集中力較差時，轉為做練習。
