王少清救護見習支隊獲得步操比賽冠軍、家居護理亞軍和總成績殿軍。



恶劣天氣以外緊急情況 本校將會作出特别安排

教育局於本年六月十一日發出第9/2015號通告,建議學校在緊急情況下作出的各項安排。該通告述明,因惡劣天氣以外的緊急情況,教育局以學生的安全為首要考慮因素,或會建議全港或個別地區的幼稚園、小學、中學及特殊學校停課。

- 1. 經本校法團校董會全面評估及深入商討後,於上述情況下,本校會依照教育局的建議停課。換言之,當教育局發出停課建議的公布,家長不應送貴子弟回校。
- 2. 就本校停課的安排,請家長隨時留意載於學校網頁或手機短訊的公布。

Self-Regulated Learning-The Pathway to Learners' Autonomy

What is Self-Regulated Learning (SRL)?

It is a learning mode promoting autonomy. In the past, we used to put emphasis on teachers' talk and set instructional materials. However, the above teaching method may not cater for the learning needs of students anymore nowadays. For example, students do not feel that they are the owners of their learning process. This results in their loss of interest and motivation. SRL is trying to remedy this problem and encourages students to be in charge of their learning like preparation for the next lesson and sharing among peers.
