



#### **Annual Walkathon for Walk to Build**

#### Why take part?

What's better than spending a morning on a weekend with your family and friends outdoors while lending a helping hand to those underprivileged kids in the rural areas of China? At our walkathon this year, we will be joining hands together and raising funds for Walk To Build, a charity which is devoted to providing education for the impoverished in China. Therefore, for every step we take at the walkathon, we are changing the destiny of those children who have been craving for a chance to receive education in order to end their poverty and plight that ensue. Come and join us! We will walk for a good cause!

#### The route of the walk

The walk will begin in the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, which is deliberately chosen to represent our hope that every child around the globe can have an equal opportunity to receive education. The destination of the walk is Western Kowloon Cultural District. It takes about an hour to complete the walk.

Along the route, not only can we go through some of the most recognized academic buildings in Hong Kong, but we can also enjoy the spectacular scenery of Victoria Harbor. Before the walk comes to an end, several local artists will stage a performance at Western Kowloon Cultural District so as to show their support to the fundraising activity as well as raise public awareness. We can then take this opportunity to relax and refresh ourselves.

#### The work of Walk To Build

Walk To Build has been utilizing their proceeds to construct school campuses and school facilities for underprivileged children living in rural China. Holding a strong belief that education is the key to help children escape from the vicious cycle of cross-generation poverty, they have constructed over 10 schools in remote areas of China and more than 5000 children could benefit from the project. This year, Walk To Build aims to further expand the scale of the project and targets to build over 20 schools.

Apart from constructing school facilities in China, Walk To Build also provides training, teaching materials and support for teachers. The charity not only brings in new and inspiring teaching methods for teachers there but also subsidizes exchange programmes with schools in other provinces to promote the effectiveness of teaching and learning.
