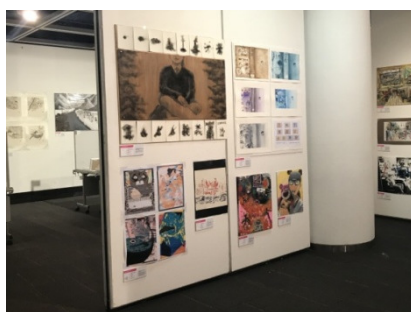


第三屆香港城市大學中學生傑出作品展

「逆風前航」－提升子女抗逆力家長講座



青少年在成長的階段中難免碰上逆境和困難的時候，家長面對子女的成長時，亦會遇到不少的挑戰。爲了讓家長掌握如何培育子女正向人生觀、提昇協助子女面對逆境的能力以及促進家庭關係，本校與香港家庭福利會，於5月5日下午舉辦「逆風前航」家長講座，並邀請香港家庭福利會社工許姑娘到場講解協助家長了解青少年價值觀及溝通方法、認識抗逆力的概念及加強協助子女面對逆境的策略。是次講座爲衛生署「好心情@學校」計劃的活動之一。



靜觀體驗工作坊

近年，年青人的抗壓能力成爲社會熱話。莘莘學子面對學業、社交、青春期身心轉變等沉重壓力時，有時難免無所適從。有見及此，本校在5月11日下午舉辦「靜觀體驗工作坊」，透過靜觀體驗，讓同學認識和了解自身的情緒和感受，抒發情緒和壓力。



活動中，靜觀訓練治療導師Sharon Chan講解「靜觀」的由來、概念，並和30多位同學進行靜觀呼吸法、身體掃描、伸展運動、體驗活動、反思、討論及分享，以使提升他們管理壓力及情緒的能力、提升專注力和抗逆力，及讓他們學習到以寬容、感恩的心去面對生活上的人和事。導師表示，經過靜觀訓練後，習慣觀靜者將擁有較強的覺察和專注力，尤其對負面情緒的覺察，即使陷入生氣和情緒波動時，他們亦可即刻意識得到，並從而調整情緒和思想。當天，同學均投入體驗活動，也認同靜觀訓練能夠舒解壓力。

Student’s Writing

This year, our F3 students learnt to write a Shakespearean sonnet. Of course their Sonnets may not be as good as Shakespeare’s, however, their message is strong, amazing and creative. Hopefully you can understand their world more when you enjoy their sonnets.

Here are some Q&As to help you understand more about their work.

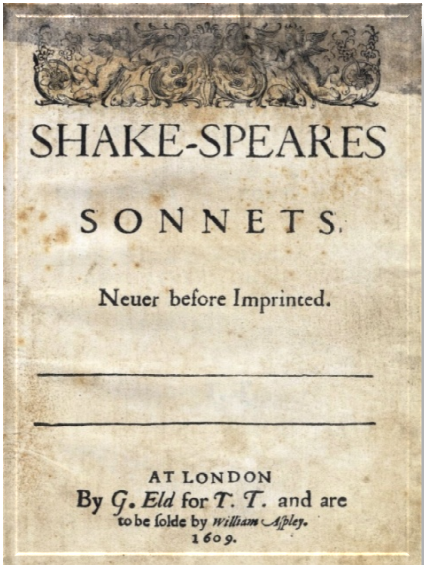
Q:What is a 14-line poem called?

A:Not all 14-line poems have specific names, but the name of the most famous type of 14-line poem is**the sonnet**. Sonnets come in two major forms, Petrarchan, or Italian, and **Shakespearean, or English**.

Q: What is a Shakespearean sonnet?

A: Shakespeare modified the sonnet to fit the English language. The divisions of the Shakespearean sonnet are three sets of four lines called quatrains and a final couplet. The Shakespearean sonnet has **the rhyme scheme ABABCDDEFEGG**and is written in iambic pentameter.

Most of the Shakespearean Sonnets are basically based on human behaviour and problems. There can be some exaggeration also but if the soul meaning is powerful, contradictions can be neglected.

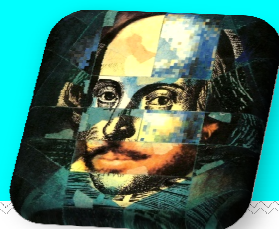
